BEER USED FOR INNOVATIVE FLOOR TREATMENT AT LAZLO'S BREWERY & GRILL

On Independence Day, Lazlo's Brewery & Grill-Haymarket location will be closed for the installation of a new floor in the dining room. The floor treatment of choice is an innovative process using house-brewed beer from Empyrean Brewing Company as a concrete stain.

“To most contractors, a concrete floor is just another concrete floor,” explained Todd Rose, co-owner of TODDROSE decorative concrete, inc., the company pioneering the beer-stain technique in Lincoln, “to me it is a way to increase the beauty of my client's space, showcase the decorative concrete industry and make people say ‘what the hell is that guy thinking!’”
